## What is this product?

### Type

This is an investment fund established as a Company With Variable Capital (SICAV).

### Objectives

**Investment objective** This Sub-Fund's objective is to create added value by implementing the investment policy by the Investment Manager.

**Investment policies** The Sub-Fund will mainly invest (directly or indirectly) in debt and/or debt related securities of any country of issuance even low rated.

It may also invest up to 30% of its net assets in listed equities or listed equity related securities worldwide and/or in asset-backed securities and/or mortgage-backed securities. Investments in asset-backed securities and/or mortgage-backed securities will however not represent more than 20% its assets.

On an ancillary basis, the Sub-Fund will be able to invest in other eligible assets other than debt or debt related securities such as, but not limited to, time deposits and Money Market Instruments. No more than 10% of the assets of the Sub-Fund may in aggregate be invested in units or shares of other UCITS and/or UCIs (including money market funds).

In addition, the Sub-Fund may also use, for the purpose of efficient portfolio management, proxy hedging and investments currency forwards and options, as well as listed futures (and related options) on government bonds, equities, interest rates and currencies.

In addition, the Flexible Bond Sub-Fund may also invest up to 20% of its net assets in contingent convertibles ("CoCos") and may invest up to 10% of its net assets in structured products, provided that they qualify as transferable securities.

Ancillary liquid assets (i.e. bank deposits at sight) will be limited to 20% of the Sub-Fund's net assets.

Up to 100% of the Sub-Fund's net assets may be invested in short-term negotiable debt securities, money market instruments, time deposits and/or money market funds, under very specific market conditions such as the 2008 Lehman Brothers bankruptcy, understanding these investments will comply with all applicable investment restrictions in terms of eligibility and legal and/or specific risk diversification.

Hedging techniques may be used but there is no guarantee that it will be effective. The Sub-Fund may also use, for the purpose of

investments, efficient portfolio management and proxy hedging, techniques and instruments.

**Benchmark** The Sub-Fund is actively managed without reference to any benchmark.

**Redemption and Dealing** Investors may purchase or sell shares of the Sub-Fund on any business day in Luxembourg.

**Distribution Policy** Any income generated by the Sub-Fund is reinvested to grow the value of the shares.

**Launch date** The Sub-Fund was launched on 08/11/2016 and the share class was launched on 04/11/2016.

**Fund Currency** The base currency of the Sub-Fund is EUR.

**Conversion of units/shares** Shareholders are allowed to request the conversion of all or part of their shares into shares of another class/sub-fund subject to the conditions and fees detailed in the prospectus of the Fund.

### Intended retail investor

This product is intended for investors who plan to stay invested for at least 3 years and are prepared to take on a low level of risk of loss to their original capital in order to get a higher potential return. It is designed to form part of a portfolio of investments.

### Term

The Fund is open-ended and has no maturity date. The PRIIP manufacturer, Waystone Management Company (Lux) S.A., is not entitled to terminate this product unilaterally, and the Fund cannot be automatically terminated.

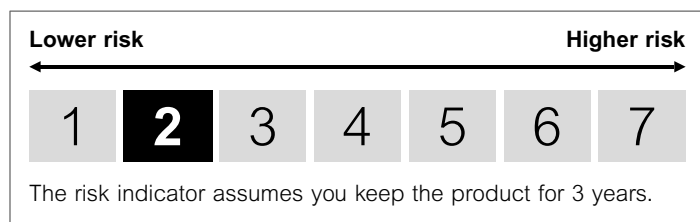

## What are the risks and what could I get in return?

### Risk Indicator

## What happens if Waystone Management Company (Lux) S.A. is unable to pay out?

The Management Company has no obligation to pay out since the Fund design does not contemplate any such payment being made. You are not covered by any national compensation scheme. To protect you, the assets are held with a separate company, a depository. Should the Fund default, the depository would liquidate the investments and distribute the proceeds to the investors. In the worst case, however, you could lose your entire investment.

## What are the costs?

The person advising on or selling you this product may charge you other costs. If so, this person will provide you with information about these costs and how they affect your investment.

### Costs over time

The tables show the amounts that are taken from your investment to cover different types of costs. These amounts depend on how much you invest, how long you hold the product. The amounts shown here are illustrations based on an example investment amount and different possible investment periods.

We have assumed:

- in the first year you would get back the amount that you invested (0% annual return). For the other holding periods we have assumed the product performs as shown in the moderate scenario,

- 10,000 EUR is invested.
